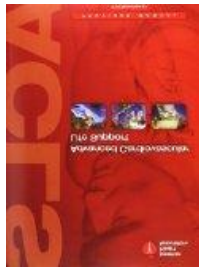

- Establish a peripheral IV line for ACLS drugs
